33. SPECIAL CLASS

To celebrate the **Ruby Anniversary of Barastoc** the APHA will conduct a **Material class.**

Entry is open to all Palominos entered in the Palomino section of Barastoc that are registered with the APHA and owned by an APHA member. No qualifications are required for this class.

The class will consist of the horse completing a ridden workout and then being stripped down for inspection and in hand presentation by the rider. The class will be marked - 60% ridden and 40% in hand. A strapper is permitted to hold the horse when it is being unsaddled by the rider – assistance to unsaddle may be given to young children only. The cost of this class is \$15.

The winner will receive a sash & trophy. All other competitors will receive a commemorative “Barastoc Ruby Anniversary” sash.

Regulations

- All horses are to be registered with a recognised Palomino Association and a copy of registration to be attached.
- All exhibitors are to be Current Financial Members of a recognised Palomino Association - copy of membership to be attached.
- Horse handlers or riders who are not a member of either the APHA Inc or EFA will be required to complete a Non EFA/APHA member waiver and pay \$20.00. Copies of membership of EFA or APHA Inc must be attached to entry for all handlers and riders. No waiver and fee - no show.
- Horses are permitted to be plaited. Performances are not required for classes 1-30 & 33.
- Exhibitors are to supply their own exhibit numbers in a suitable holder.
- Riders in rider classes and Handlers will be required to supply proof of age, if requested, on the day and must be leading or mounted on a Palomino that has already been entered in either a led and/or ridden class in the Palomino section at Barastoc.
- Entry fee is \$15.00 per class - classes 1 - 30 & 33.
- Exhibitors will be required to pay the compulsory NEC Werribee facility fee of \$11.00 (GST inc) per horse per day with their entries. (Note: new payment)
- All exhibitors must refer to the Barastoc Website (www.BarastocShow.com) on or after the 1st February 2009 for information relating to the conduct of the Show. Especially the new arrangements for access to the Equestrian Centre for **vehicles not used** for the transport of horses.
- Exhibitors will not be issued with Complimentary Passes. However, exhibitors may purchase an Exhibitor's Pass (\$25.00 GST inc) with their entries. An Exhibitor's Pass will admit an exhibitor's horse transporting vehicle and its occupants. Only exhibitors able to produce an Exhibitor's Pass will be allowed entry to the venue, at no charge. Where an Exhibitor's Pass cannot be produced, the following Admission Charges will apply:-

CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS

The Australian Palomino Horsebreeders Association Inc has created a new event that will be judged at the Barastoc Horse of the Year Show. This event is the Champion of Champions trophy for both led horses and ridden horses. We will have a second judge for the Champion of Champions section only.

The rules are as follows:-

- Entry fee for both led and ridden is \$25.00 per class.
- All Led Champions and all Ridden Champions will compete against each other to determine the Champion of Champions - Led or Ridden.
- PLEASE NOTE CHANGES TO QUALIFICATIONS:
- To qualify for this event the horse nominated must have won one Champion Palomino in either Led (eg Champion Mare/Filly, Champion Stallion/Colt or Champion Gelding) or Ridden (eg Champion Ridden exhibit, Champion Ridden Mare) at an official APHA Double Points Show OR has won TWO Palomino Championships in either led or ridden in the Palomino classes at an Agricultural or Open Horse show but stallion classes must have been included in the Palomino schedule.
- Championships must have been gained from 1st December 2006 to 30th November 2008 to coincide with the Barastoc Horse of the Year show. (This has been extended due to EI)
- Details must be shown on the entry form (name & date of show and award won - eg Champion Led Palomino mare - Lilydale Show - 18th November 2008).
- The judging of the classes will take place at the Barastoc Horse of the Year Show.
- The winner will receive a sash and trophy.

Horse Sports are a Dangerous Activity

In consideration for being permitted to participate in any way in horse sport activities and in particular this event, I, the undersigned, understand, acknowledge and accept that:

Horse sports are a dangerous recreational activity and horses can act in a sudden and unpredictable (changeable) way, especially if frightened or hurt.

There is a significant risk that serious **INJURY** or **DEATH** may result from horse sport activities and in particular this event.

I knowingly and freely assume all such risks, both known and unknown, even if arising from the negligence of The Equestrian Federation of Australia and/or the event organiser (hereafter referred to as the "Releasees") or others and I **voluntarily PARTICIPATE** at my **OWN RISK** and assume sole responsibility for any injury, death or property damage I may suffer that arises from my participation in horse sport activities.

I understand and acknowledge the dangers associated with the consumption of alcohol or any mind altering drugs before and during the activity and I take full responsibility for any injury, loss or damage associated with their consumption. I agree not to drink alcohol or take drugs prohibited by law before or during this event.

I agree to follow the directions of any event organiser or official and that any misconduct or refusal by me to follow any direction of any organiser or official can result in the **CANCELLATION** of my participation in the event and my immediate removal from my horse **NO MATTER** where that may occur. I understand that any such non-compliance may result in injury, death and/or permanent disability and I agree to indemnify the Releasees against all claims made by any person as a result of my failure to comply.

I agree to wear a helmet at all times whilst participating in the sport where this is required under the relevant EFA and FEI rules and regulations and agree that I am solely responsible for ensuring that whilst participating I wear a suitable helmet at all times where required under the relevant EFA and FEI rules and regulations and take sole responsibility for my actions.

I, for myself and on behalf of my heirs, assigns, personal representatives and next of kin, hereby release and hold harmless and agree not to sue The Equestrian Federation of Australia and/or the event organiser, their officers, officials, volunteers, coaches, agents and/or employees, other participants, sponsoring agencies, sponsors, state bodies, affiliated clubs and if applicable, owners and lessors of premises used to conduct the activities (all of whom are referred to as "Releasees") with respect to any and all injury, disability, death, or loss or damage to person or property, whether caused by the negligence of the releasees or otherwise.

Effect of this Document

I have had sufficient opportunity to read this release of liability and assumption of risk agreement, fully understand its terms, understand that I have given up substantial rights by signing it, and sign it freely and voluntarily without inducement of any kind.

I understand that my signature to this document constitutes a complete and unconditional release of all liability of the Releasees, to the greatest extent allowed by law in the event of me and/or the children under my care, suffering injury or death.
