## Regulations

- Qualifications are not required for this APSB section of Barastoc Horse of the Year.
  - Due to limited time availability classes CANNOT be held up for exhibitors in other sections of the show.
  - **Non Financial Members of EA must sign the Insurance Waiver, and pay the levy as per rule 6 in the conditions of entry**
  - TIMETABLE - The allocation of times will be finalised once entries close and the number of entries per class is known.
  - All ponies/horses are to be registered with the CPBSA or APSB. A **copy of registration/s** to be attached. For eligibility for Supreme APSB Exhibit proof of APSB membership and registration papers must be provided with entry.
  - All exhibitors of pure-bred registered ponies/horses are to be current financial members of either the CPBSA or APSB - **copy of membership and registration papers** to be attached to entry. Part-bred exhibitors require registration papers only.
  - All horse handlers or riders who are not a member of Equestrian Victoria will be required to complete a Non EA member waiver and pay \$25.00. Copies of membership of must be attached to entry for all handlers and riders. **No waiver, no fee - no show.**
  - Entry fee is \$15.00 per class
  - Exhibitors will be required to pay the compulsory NEC Werribee facility fee of \$11.00 (GST inc) per horse per day with their entries. □ All exhibitor support vehicle/s (ie **non horse transport vehicles**) will not be given access to the Venue between 6am - 6pm daily. SEE TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT PLAN FOR FURTHER DETAILS.
  - Exhibitors will not be issued with Complimentary Passes. However, exhibitors may purchase an Exhibitor's Pass (\$25.00 GST inc) with their entries. An Exhibitor's Pass will admit an exhibitor's horse transporting vehicle and its occupants. Only exhibitors able to produce an Exhibitor's Pass will be allowed entry to the venue, at no charge. Where an Exhibitor's Pass cannot be produced, the following Admission Charges will apply:-

  - Scratching - a refund of entry fees only (NEC fees, waiver fees and Exhibitor passes are non refundable) will be provided if a Veterinary Certificate is produced within 7 days of informing the Show Co-ordinator of the scratching. This will apply to a scratching that occurs between 1st January 2010 (close of entries) and 1st February 2010. No refunds will be provided for scratching after the 1st February 2010.

**BARASTOC HORSE OF THE YEAR SHOW**

**PARKING**

**Wednesday 17<sup>th</sup> – Sunday 21<sup>st</sup> February Inclusive**

Due to the number of horses competing at the Barastoc Horse of the Year Show, a Traffic Management Plan has been prepared and will be implemented for the 2010 Show. In summary, the Plan will restrict access to the Equestrian Centre Precinct for non horse transport vehicles between 6.00am – 6.00pm daily.

**\*\*\*All horse transport vehicles** must enter the Equestrian Centre Precinct via. **Gate 3**, which is the Main Entrance to the Centre. These vehicles will then park in accordance with the allocation of facilities, location of yards, competition rings, etc. Entry will be by ticket (Exhibitors Pass) or payment of an admission fees.

**\*\*\*All non horse transport vehicles** must enter the Werribee Park Precinct via. **Gate 2**, which is the Main Entrance to the Park. These vehicles will then be parked in the Paddock at the back of the Equestrian Centre and occupants will enter via. the back Gate located near the Showjumping Arena. Entry will be by ticket and/or payment of an admission fee. Courtesy buses will be available from 7am daily to transport people around the venue.

Vehicle Pass/s to allow access to the Equestrian Centre Precinct will be issued at the discretion of the Organising Committee or its appointed representative. Entry will be from the back paddock parking area only. Once unloaded the vehicle may park on the venue on the understanding it will remain in one spot until 6.00pm. Vehicles found moving around the venue unnecessarily will have the Vehicle Pass confiscated and access to the Equestrian Centre Precinct will be denied for the remainder of the Show.

The Organising Committee, Equestrian Victoria and Werribee Park Equestrian Centre Management look forward to your cooperation. This plan has been designed to protect you, your family and horses.

## **CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

(All entry fees, admission charges and prize money is GST inclusive.)

**1. Close of Entries:** Entries Close on **Friday 1<sup>st</sup> January 2010 at 4.30pm.**

**2.** The Barastoc Organising Committee reserves the right to accept or reject any entry or vary the conditions of any event or to cancel any event without assigning a reason.

### **3. Facility Fee**

Exhibitors will be required to pay a compulsory **Facility Fee of \$11.00 per horse/pony entered, per day.** This fee will be passed onto the Werribee Park National Equestrian Centre.

### **4. Security Fee**

In order to protect the venue, sponsor signs and exhibitors equipment, the Committee has decided to set a fee to cover the cost of overnight security during the 2010 Show. Exhibitors will be required to pay a compulsory Security Fee of \$5.00 per horse/pony entered.

### **6. Insurance – Applies to all classes**

Competitors (Riders & Handlers) who are not financial members of Equestrian Victoria must include an additional \$25.00, for **Public Liability Insurance**, and include a signed Waiver (attached to entry form)

The Equestrian Australia membership number must be shown on the entry form, in the space provided.

(Note – Must be Junior, Senior or Horse Membership.( Official/Supporter level of membership not accepted)

\*\*See special Membership offer which provides Equestrian Victoria membership until 30<sup>th</sup> June for a fee of \$50. This fee includes insurance which covers the person for Barastoc and at all times when riding their horse during the membership period.

### **7. Exhibit Numbers**

Exhibit Numbers will be supplied by the Organizing Committee. Exhibitors will be required to collect their numbers from the Secretary's office on arrival.

Exhibitors will be issued with their paid copy of the program, when collecting Exhibit Numbers.

### **8. Exhibitor Passes**

Exhibitors will not be issued with Complimentary Passes. However, exhibitors may purchase an Exhibitors Pass (\$25) with their entries. An Exhibitors Pass will admit an exhibitor's horse transporting vehicle and its occupants. Only exhibitors able to produce an Exhibitors Pass will be allowed entry to the venue, at no charge. Where an Exhibitors Pass cannot be produced the following admission charges will apply.

**An Exhibitor Pass cannot be obtained at the gate and occupants of support vehicle will be required to pay admission charges.**

### **9. Drug Testing and Swabbing**

The Committee reserves the right to take blood and/or urine samples from all or any horse/s present at Werribee Park in accordance with the EA Rules and/or the relevant regulations contained in the Royal Agricultural Society of Victoria's Prize Schedule for Horse

Events.

### **10. Objections (All except showjumping)**

Any objections or protests must be made in writing and signed, and handed to the secretary with a deposit of AUS\$100 prior to the commencement of judging for the class concerned or within thirty (30) minutes after presentation of sashes/ribbons. The Committee or their appointed representative/s shall determine the objection and will call such evidence as they think fit. If the decision goes against the objector, he/she will forfeit his/her deposit of AUS\$100 and be liable for any expenses occasioned by the objection.

Should the objection be allowed by the Committee, the deposit will be refunded.

Should the objector wish to appeal the Committee's decision, he/she must lodge an appeal in accordance with the rules of Equestrian Australia.

### **14. Handler's Attire**

Horses may be held in Ring centre during preliminary judging, however handlers must be correctly dressed. Handlers wearing shorts and thongs, or tracksuits will not be permitted into the ring.

### **15. Eligibility for Championship Awards**

In Sections where a Panel of Judges carries out the judging of the "Championship Award", the onus is on the owner/exhibitor to ensure the horse and themselves are eligible to compete under any of the Judges concerned. No Judge will stand aside for the judging of a "Championship Award".

### **16. Age of Horses**

The minimum age of a horse competing in the Saddle Sections is three (3) years of age.

### **17. Whips**

The maximum length for whips is 78 cm, including flaps.

### **18. Costume**

When riding ponies 14 hands & under riders must wear appropriate riding attire.

### **19. Helmets**

Approved Equestrian Helmets must be worn at all times when riding at the Werribee Park National Equestrian Centre.
