2010 Barastoc Horse of the Year Show
Wednesday 17th - Sunday 21st February inclusive

On behalf of the Barastoc Horse of the Year Show Planning Committee and Equestrian Victoria, I would like to thank you for entering the 41st Barastoc Horse of the Year Show. Unless you have heard otherwise, all entries as nominated have been accepted for competition. Set out below are details of administrative arrangements for your information: -

1. STABLING

2. MEASURING

All exhibitors must be able to produce a current Height Certificate for their horse upon request. **See special conditions relating to Newcomer & Open Saddle Classes below.**

The Royal Agricultural Society of Victoria's 2009 Royal Show and 2010 Summer Show Measurement Certificates and/or EFA Official Measurements will be accepted on production of the relevant documents, provided the horse was 6 years old or over at the time of Measurement.

Special Conditions for Section 16 (Newcomer Saddle) and Section 20 (Open Saddle) Horses/Ponies – Horses/Ponies do not have to be measured prior to Preliminary Judging. However, all FINALISTS must be measured prior to entering the ring for FINAL Judging. If a Newcomer or Open Saddle FINALIST measures over or under the required height, the exhibit will not be permitted to transfer to the correct height class, and will therefore be eliminated from any further competition in the either Section

Horses and Ponies not measured prior to the Show must be presented for measuring prior to judging. In the event of a height variation, an exhibit will be transferred to the correct class.

All exhibitors may be requested to produce an Original Height Certificate on the day. Exhibitors not able to do so will have to be measured.

The Measuring Stand will be open as follows:-

Wednesday 17 th	-	10.00am – 6.00pm
Thursday 18 th	-	8.00am – 6.00pm
Friday 19 th	-	8.00am onwards
Saturday 20 th	-	8.00am – 2.00pm
Sunday 21 st	-	8.00am – 11.00am

If you miss these times, measuring will only be done by agreement of the Measurers and the payment of a \$50 fee for the first horse/pony and \$20 for each additional horse/pony.

All exhibitors must carry their Height Certificate in their pocket whilst competing. The Steward will check Height Certificates. Any exhibitor unable to present a height certificate will not be permitted to compete.

3. COMMENTARY INFORMATION (Classes 64 – 68, 217 - 220 and 228 – 232 inclusive)

A form to provide information for the Commentator will be handed to finalists on the day of competition. This form must be completed and handed into the Secretary's Office at least thirty (30) minutes prior to the start of judging of the Final. **Commentary Forms are mandatory for these classes and must be provided prior to participation in the finals.**

4. BARASTOC SADDLE HORSE CLASSES - FINALIST WORKOUTS

All workouts are on the Barastoc & Equestrian Victoria Websites and will be printed in the Official Program, which will be available from the Gatekeeper and the Secretary's office.

5. OFFICIAL PROGRAM

Prepaid programs will be distributed from the Secretary's office or by the Gatekeeper on presentation of the correct "Collection Voucher", which has been sent to you by mail.

If you misplace, lose or forget the "Collection Voucher", you may purchase a program at the standard sale price - \$10 each.

6. OFFICIAL DRAWS (Newcomers & Open Saddle Sections)

In classes where entries exceed forty (40), preliminary judging will take place in heats to minimise waiting time for competitors. The following classes will be judged in heats: -

7. DRESSAGE DRAWS

8. OWNER RIDER CHAMPIONSHIP - SECTION 21

Classes 233 – 236 inclusive will be judged as classes. Judging will commence immediately after the Preliminary Judging of the Barastoc Open Saddle Classes on Sunday 21st February. Due to the number of entries, there will be two (2) Judges used as follows:

Judge 1	Hacks & Small Ponies
Judge 2	Galloways & Large Ponies

*** Any Horse, Galloway or Pony which places as champion or reserve in the Newcomer (Section 16), Show Hunter under Saddle (Section 12) or Open Saddle (Section 20) classes at the current Barastoc Horse of the Year Show is not eligible to compete in any of the Owner Rider Classes (Section 21).**

*** Any competitor who rides a Horse, Galloway or Pony which places as champion or reserve in the Newcomer (Section 16), Show Hunter under Saddle (Section 12) or Open Saddle (Section 20) classes at the current Barastoc Horse of the Year Show is not eligible to ride a horse in any of the Owner Rider Classes (Section 21).**

9. JUNIOR SADDLE - SECTION 5

Classes 44 – 47 inclusive will be judged as classes in Indoor Arena No 1 (Ring 4) on Thursday 18th February commencing at 6.00pm.

10. FODDER/BEDDING

11. EQUIPMENT

Exhibitors are requested to bring their own gear for watering, feeding and cleaning of exhibits and yards. There are a limited number of horse washes (8) at Werribee Park.

12. DRESS

For all events, exhibits and exhibitors are required to turnout in Royal Show standard.

13. AWARDS

Awards will be made in accordance with the Schedule of Prizes and Official Catalogue. Awards may not be made in classes where less than two competitors start.

14. CATERING

Catering outlets will operate from 7.00am daily, offering a full range of snack foods and refreshments for competitors and the public.

Bar - The Friends of Werribee Park Equestrian Centre will operate a bar in the Indoor Arena No 1 on Thursday 18th & Friday 19th February from 5pm.

Note: There will be a free sausage sizzle for competitors in Indoor Arena No 1 on Thursday 18th & Friday 19th from 6.30pm – 8.30pm.

15. EXHIBIT NUMBERS

Exhibit numbers **will be** provided by the Organising Committee and competitors must collect their numbers from the Secretary's Office.

It is strongly recommended that competitors purchase an Exhibit Number holder (from your local Saddlery Store), for both Led & Saddle Classes. This will ensure your exhibit number lasts the whole Show. A charge of \$5.00 per number, will apply for replacement numbers.

16. COMPETITOR PACK (Open Saddle Section 20 Only)

Barastoc souvenir packs (classes 228 – 232 only) will be distributed from the Event Office on presentation of the "collection form". If you misplace, lose or forget the "collection form", the **Barastoc** souvenir pack will not be issued.

17. COMPETITOR PACK (Junior Saddle Section 5 Only)

Horse Deals souvenir packs (classes 44 – 47 only) will be distributed from the Event Office on presentation of the "collection form". If you misplace, lose or forget the "collection form", the **Horse Deals** souvenir pack will not be issued.



18. EXERCISING OF EXHIBITS

Exhibitors must not exercise horses on the Polo Field; any exhibitor found to be doing so may be eliminated. Exhibitors are asked to use discretion when exercising in order not to interfere with any judging that may be in process or due to take place.

The Indoor Arenas will also be available for exercising horses (no lunging) as follows: -

28. OBJECTIONS

Any objections or protests must be made in writing and signed, and handed to the Secretary with a deposit of AU\$150.00 prior to the commencement of judging for the class concerned or within thirty (30) minutes after presentation of sashes/ribbons. The Committee or their appointed representative/s shall determine the objection and will call such evidence, as they think fit. If the decision goes against the objector, he/she will forfeit his/her deposit of AU\$100.00 and be liable for any expenses occasioned by the objection. Should the Committee allow the objection, the deposit will be refunded.

Should the objector wish to appeal the Committee's decision, he/she must lodge an appeal in accordance with the rules of The Equestrian Federation of Australia Limited
