Conditions of Entry:

- * All Competitors must be financial members of the HRCVAV
- * HRCVAV Rules and Regulations to apply
- * Entries must be on HRCVAV 2010 Standard Entry Form
- * Membership and Showing Cards must be handed to Card Secretary no later than 30 minutes prior to the first class (no cards—no ride)
- * Competitors must supply their own exhibit numbers
- * Stallions are eligible
- * All Exhibitors must refer to the Barastoc website www.barastocshow.com on/or after 1st February 2010 for information relating to the conduct of the Show. Especially the new arrangements for access to the Equestrian Centre for **vehicles not used** for the transport for the transport of horses.

- * \$11.00 Werribee Park Facility Fee applies per horse per day and is to be included with entry
- * Medical Armbands are required for all jumping phases

LOCATION:
The HRCVAV Classes will be conducted on grass (part of the polo fields) at the 2010 Show (the same area as the 2009 Barastoc HRCVAV Showing). Parking around two sides of the location will be possible. Also, due to pressure on yards, competitors are encouraged not to arrive at the Centre until the day of competition.

EXHIBITOR PASSES (Please note: Competitors must have a pre-purchased exhibitors pass)
Exhibitors will not be issued with Complimentary Passes. However, exhibitors must purchase an **Exhibitors Pass** (\$25.00 Inclusive of GST) with their entries. An **Exhibitors Pass** will admit an exhibitors horse transporting vehicle and its occupants. Only exhibitors able to produce an **Exhibitors Pass** will be allowed entry to the venue, at no charge. Where an **Exhibitors Pass** cannot be produced, the following admission charges will apply: (inclusive of GST)-
