Entry is open to all Palominos entered in the Palomino section of Barastoc. No qualifications are required for this class.
The class will consist of the horse completing a ridden workout and only the **top 6** horses then being stripped down for inspection and then shown in hand by the rider.
The class will be marked - 60% ridden and 40% in hand.
A strapper is permitted to hold the horse when it is being unsaddled by the rider – assistance to unsaddle may be given to young children.
The entry fee for this class is \$15.
The winner will receive a sash & trophy. Placegetters 2nd to 4th will receive a sash.

Regulations

- All horses are to be registered with the Australian Palomino Horsebreeders Association and a copy of registration to be attached.
- All exhibitors are to be Current Financial Members of the Australian Palomino Horsebreeders Association - copy of membership to be attached.
- Horse handlers or riders who are not a member of either the APHA Inc or EA will be required to complete a Non EA/APHA member waiver and pay \$20.00. Copies of membership of EA or APHA Inc must be attached to entry for all handlers and riders. No waiver and fee - no show.
- Horses are permitted to be plaited. Performances are not required for classes 1-29 & 34.
- Exhibitors are to supply their own exhibit numbers in a suitable holder.
- Riders and Handlers will be required to supply proof of age, if requested, on the day and must be leading or mounted on a Palomino that has already been entered in either a led and/or ridden class in the Palomino section at Barastoc.
- Entry fee is \$15.00 per class - classes 1 - 29 & 34.
- Exhibitors will be required to pay the compulsory NEC Werribee facility fee of \$11.00 (GST inc) per horse per day with their entries.
- All exhibitor support vehicle/s (ie non horse transport vehicles) will not be given access to the Venue between 6am - 6pm daily. SEE TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT PLAN FOR FURTHER DETAILS.
- Exhibitors will not be issued with Complimentary Passes. However, exhibitors may purchase an Exhibitor's Pass (\$25.00 GST inc) with their entries. An Exhibitor's Pass will admit an exhibitor's horse transporting vehicle and its occupants. Only exhibitors able to produce an Exhibitor's Pass will be allowed entry to the venue, at no charge. Where an Exhibitor's Pass cannot be produced, the following Admission Charges will apply:-

An Exhibitor Pass cannot be obtained at the Gate and occupants of any support vehicle will be required to pay Admission Charges as above.

- Stable/Yard/Camping fees - Please contact the WPNEC directly for bookings - Ph 9741 7672.
- Scratching - a refund of entry fees only (NEC fees, waiver fees and Exhibitor passes are non refundable) will be provided if a Veterinary Certificate is produced within 7 days of informing the Show Co-ordinator of the scratching. This will apply to a scratching that occurs between 1st January 2010 (close of entries) and 1st February 2010. No refunds will be provided for scratching after the 1st February 2010. Refunds are at the discretion of the APHA Show Committee.

CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS

The Australian Palomino Horsebreeders Association Inc is proud to present the Champion of Champions trophy for both led horses and ridden horses. We will have a second judge for the Champion of Champions section only.

The rules are as follows:-

- Entry fee for both led and ridden is \$25.00 per class.
- Horses wishing to compete in the Champion of Champions section must have entered classes in the Barastoc HOTY Palomino section to be eligible.
- The Led Champions of Champions will be divided into Stallion/Colt, Mare/Filly and Gelding sections. Each winner will then compete for the title of Supreme Champion of Champions - Led.
- All Ridden Champions will compete against each other to determine the Champion of Champions - Ridden.

PLEASE NOTE CHANGES TO QUALIFICATIONS:

- To qualify for this event the horse nominated must have won one Champion Palomino in either Led (eg Champion Mare/Filly, Champion Stallion/Colt or Champion Gelding) or Ridden (eg Champion Ridden exhibit, Champion Ridden Mare) at an official APHA Double Points Show OR has won TWO Palomino Championships in either led or ridden in the Palomino classes at an Agricultural or Open Horse show but stallion classes must have been included in the Palomino schedule.
- Championships must have been gained from 1st December 2008 to 30th November 2009 to coincide with the Barastoc Horse of the Year show.
- Performance details must be shown on the entry form (name & date of show and award won - eg Champion Led Palomino mare - Lilydale Show - 21st November 2009).
- The judging of the classes will take place at the Barastoc Horse of the Year Show.
- The winner Supreme Champion of Champions - Led and Champion of Champions - Ridden will receive a sash and trophy.

PARKING

Wednesday 17th – Sunday 21st February Inclusive

Due to the number of horses competing at the Barastoc Horse of the Year Show, a Traffic Management Plan has been prepared and will be implemented for the 2010 Show. In summary, the Plan will restrict access to the Equestrian Centre Precinct for non horse transport vehicles between 6.00am – 6.00pm daily.

*****All horse transport vehicles** must enter the Equestrian Centre Precinct via. **Gate 3**, which is the Main Entrance to the Centre. These vehicles will then park in accordance with the allocation of facilities, location of yards, competition rings, etc. Entry will be by ticket (Exhibitors Pass) or payment of an admission fees.

*****All non horse transport vehicles** must enter the Werribee Park Precinct via. **Gate 2**, which is the Main Entrance to the Park. These vehicles will then be parked in the Paddock at the back of the Equestrian Centre and occupants will enter via. the back Gate located near the Showjumping Arena. Entry will be by ticket and/or payment of an admission fee. Courtesy buses will be available from 8am daily to transport people around the venue.

Vehicle Pass/s to allow access to the Equestrian Centre Precinct will be issued at the discretion of the Organising Committee or its appointed representative. Entry will be from the back paddock parking area only. Once unloaded the vehicle may park on the venue on the understanding it will remain in one spot until 6.00pm. Vehicles found moving around the venue unnecessarily will have the Vehicle Pass confiscated and access to the Equestrian Centre Precinct will be denied for the remainder of the Show.

The Organising Committee, Equestrian Victoria and Werribee Park Equestrian Centre Management look forward to your cooperation.
