Entry Fee: \$ 35 per horse

*includes entry to Three Classes & Exhibitors Pass (Valid – Friday 19th February only)
The Exhibitor Pass will admit the exhibitor's horse transporting vehicle and all its occupants.
Only exhibitors able to produce an Exhibitors pass will be allowed entry to the venue, at no charge.*

Where an Exhibitors Pass cannot be produced the following admission charges will apply:

Family (2 Adults & 2 Children) \$30**

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- Entries Close on Monday 14th December 2009 at 4.30pm or when classes are full - No refunds after entries close
- Exhibitors Numbers will be supplied by the organising Committee. Exhibitors will be required to collect their Exhibit numbers from the Secretary's Office on arrival.
- A maximum of 200 horses will be accepted on a first-come-first-accepted basis.
- Entry Fees include GST
- Riders who are not financial members of Equestrian Australia must include an additional \$25.00, which will provide Public Liability Insurance on the day of competition only, (For Non Member Insurance levy and special Equestrian Victoria membership offer, please refer to relevant documents on the Equestrian Victoria Website.)
- The EA membership number must be shown on the entry form, in the space provided. **(Note – Must be Junior, Senior or Show Horse membership. Official/supporter level of membership not accepted.)**
- Events are open to all riders enrolled in primary or secondary schools throughout Victoria, who have attained at least E Grade standard in showjumping, with the Pony Club Association of Victoria (PCAV) or have attained at least Level 5 in showjumping, with the Horse Riding Clubs Association of Victoria (HRCV) or be approved by their school to compete at that grade.
- All riders must be currently enrolled at the school they represent.

- Current PCAV or HRCV Grading Card must be available for inspection on the day of competition, to verify grading. Competitors must be graded on the horse they are competing on. Non PCAV and HRCV members must complete the signed declaration on the back of this entry form.
- Pony Club and HRCV graded riders must compete in their own grading.
- The Committee reserves the right to eliminate any rider deemed to be riding in an incorrect grade.
- All riders must wear Australian Standards Association (ASA) approved helmets at all times when mounted.
- School shirt, tie, jumper, competition uniform or tracksuit top and saddlecloth (if available) must be worn with beige, fawn or banana jodhpurs, or coloured jodhpurs if part of school uniform.

PRIZES

Class 1 & 2 : Ribbons to sixth placing in all sections.

Class 3 : Sash for winners. Ribbons 2nd – 6th

Overall Champions: The overall winners of each section will receive a Rug (donated by Sheldene Park Rugs) and Barastoc Horse of the Year Show Medallion
