THE BARASTOC HORSE OF THE YEAR SHOW is one of the most prestigious events on the Australian Equestrian Calendar and provides competition for a vast array of horse breeds and types. All Barastoc Saddle Championship Classes will be conducted on Sunday 15th February.

TRADE FAIR

The Trade Fair will be established in the Centre of the venue (see attached plan).

The Trade Fair will operate as follows: -

1. Allocation of sites will be on a first come first serve basis, with full payment of fees. There will be a maximum of forty-eight (48) sites available.
2. Sites 1 – 48 inclusive will have three (3) metre frontages with a maximum depth of five (5) metres. Larger sites can be obtained, however they must be in multiples of three (3) metres (e.g. 6m, 9m, 12m, etc)

Note: Sites 35 & 38 have a six (6) metre frontage x three (3) metre depth.

3. Traders who have their own display caravan/vehicle should apply for end sites and/or book three sites to ensure access.

NOTE: A Trade Exhibitor who does not book sufficient space for their display will not be permitted to operate without the consent of the Show Coordinator and the other Trade Exhibitors affected. No refunds will be issued

4. Displays beyond the front line of a Trade Site must not exceed 1.5m in width and/or 1.2m in height.

5. Power will be available as follows –

1 – 5	Power available (Must provide own leads up to 50 metres long)
6 - 14	Power Not available
15 – 38	Power available (Must provide own leads up to 50 metres long)
39 – 48	Power Not available

6. Site fees as follows –

1 – 5	\$143 (GST Inclusive)
6 – 14	\$121 (“ “)
15 – 38	\$143 (“ “)
39 – 48	\$121 (“ “)

NOTE: The site fee includes three (3) seasons' admission tickets and two (2) complimentary programs.

The Organising Committee will set aside \$50 from each site sold to place an advertisement in the Weekly Times in the week leading up to the Show. The advertisement will be used to promote the Trade Village participants and the Show.

7. Additional costs where required: -

8. All Trade Fair participants will be required to operate from Friday 13th and Sunday 15th, between 9.30am and 4.30pm.

Thursday 12th is optional.

Vehicle access to the Trade Fair will not be provided after 9.30am or before 4.30pm on each day of the Show. See note regarding Traffic Management Plan for more information.

PARKING

Wednesday 11th – Sunday 15th February Inclusive

Due to the number of horses competing at the Barastoc Horse of the Year Show, a Traffic Management Plan has been prepared and will be implemented for the 2009 Show. In summary, the Plan will restrict access to the venue for non horse transport vehicles between 6.00am – 6.00pm daily.

All non horse transport vehicles (including those belonging to Trade Exhibitors) must enter the Werribee Park Precinct via Gate 2 which is the Main Entrance to the Park. These vehicles will then be parked in the Paddock at the back of the Equestrian Centre and occupants will enter via the back Gate near the Showjumping Arena. Entry will be by ticket and/or payment of an admission fee. Courtesy buses will be available from 8am daily to transport people around the venue.

Trade Exhibitors will be issued one (1) Vehicle Pass to allow access to the venue from the back paddock parking area, for the set up of their site and delivery of stock. Once unloaded the vehicle may park on the venue on the understanding it will remain in one spot until 6.00pm. Vehicles found moving around the venue unnecessarily will have the Vehicle Pass confiscated and access to the venue will be denied for the remainder of the Show.

The Organising Committee, EFA (VB) and Werribee Park Equestrian Centre Management look forward to your cooperation.

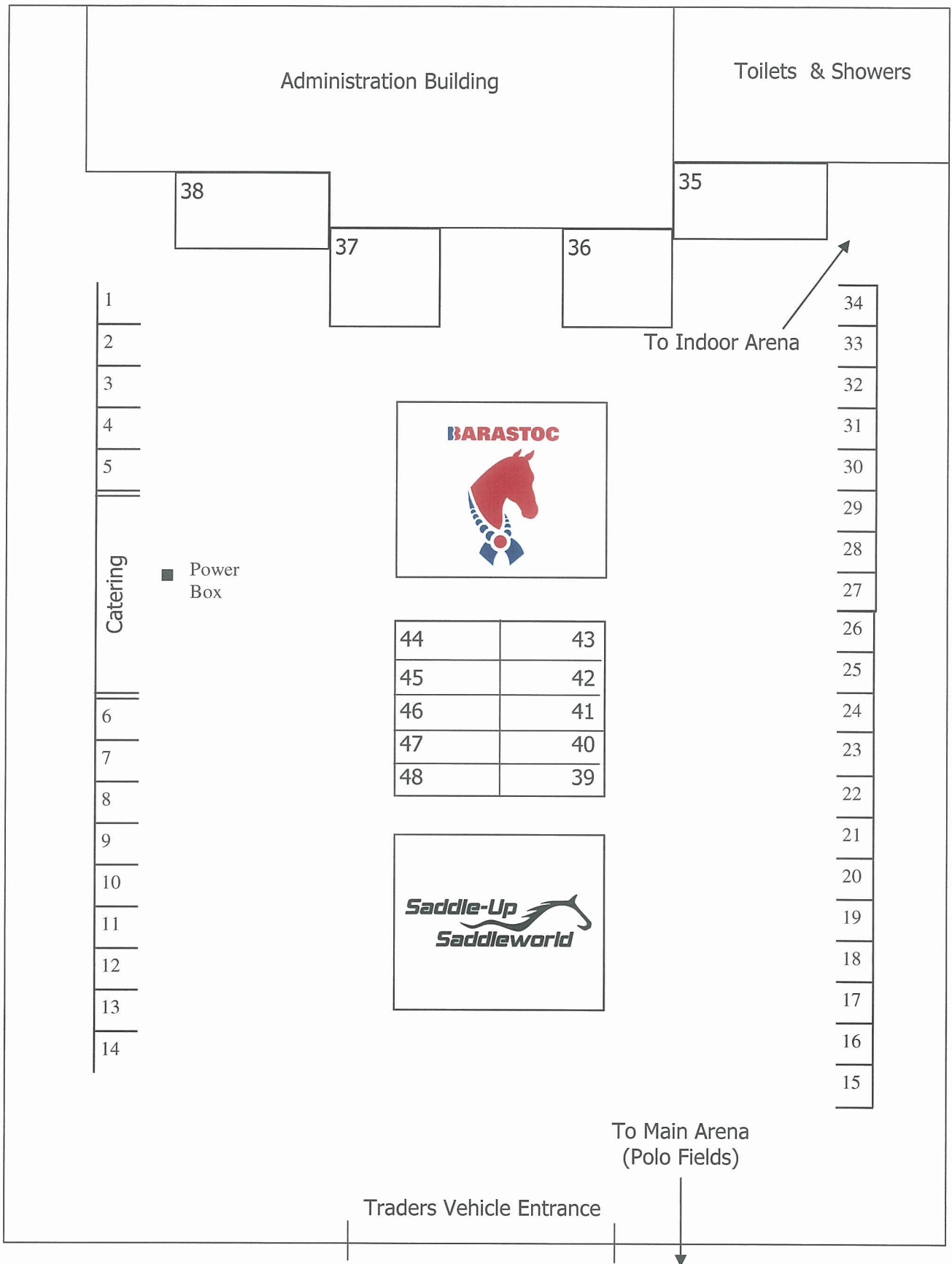
