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CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

(All entry fees, admission charges and prize money is GST inclusive.)

1. Rules & Regulations

All events will be run under Sporting Horse Australia rules.

All points acquired at Barastoc 2010 will be doubled for the Horse of the Year series 2009/2010

NOVICE - Terms and Conditions:

- Horses can earn up to & including 25 points in any junior or open **novice event** before becoming ineligible to compete in novice events.
- Points will be allocated as follows; 1st 5 points, 2nd 3 points, 3rd 1 point, 4th 0 points.
- No points will be allocated to any novice event that has less than 5 horses compete.
- Horses may continue to compete in the novice events entered on that particular day if points scored become greater than 25. Following this day the horse is no longer considered to be a novice.
- Horses with more than 25 points will no longer compete in novice regardless of rider or current/ previous owners.
- Novice cards must be presented at the start of events to the judge or penciller on the day. Cards will be returned following the completion of novice events for the day. It is the riders responsibility to collect their own card.
- The Committee of SHA reserves the right to refuse entry to any horse that they deem not to be a genuine novice horse.
- Any horse that has won any HOTYS event is ineligible to compete as a Novice

2. The Organising Committee reserves the right to accept or reject any entry or vary the conditions of any event or to cancel any event without assigning a reason.

3. Facility Fee

Exhibitors will be required to pay a compulsory **Facility Fee of \$11.00 per horse/pony entered, per day**. This fee will be passed onto the Werribee Park National Equestrian Centre.

4. Insurance

Competitors (riders) who are not members of Sporting Horse Australia must pay day Insurance and sign the appropriate Wavier Form. For Non Member Insurance Application Form and special Equestrian Victoria Membership offer go to: www.efavic.com.au

5. Exhibitor Passes

Exhibitors will not be issued with Complimentary Passes. However, exhibitors may purchase an Exhibitors Pass (\$25) with their entries. An Exhibitors Pass will admit an exhibitor's horse transporting vehicle and its occupants. Only exhibitors able to produce an Exhibitors Pass will be allowed entry to the venue, at no charge. Where an Exhibitors Pass cannot be produced the following admission charges will apply.

6. Drug Testing and Swabbing

The Committee reserves the right to take blood and/or urine samples from all or any horse entered in the Horse of the Year Show and/or horses present at Werribee Park in accordance with the FEI Rules and/or the relevant regulations contained in the Royal Agricultural Society of Victoria's Prize Schedule for Horse Events.

Please note that Day Membership and other in insurance-related arrangements may change in November 2009 or later. Please check the EA web (www.equestrian.org.au) for details.

EA Day Membership

Persons who wish to participate in horse activity days organised by an EA-insured club and who **are not registered members of this Club or members of EA**, can do so with Day Membership.

The following rules apply:

- The host club must be insured through the EA Insurance program
- The person must sign the EA Non-Member Waiver
- The person must pay the appropriate fee set by the EA National office (which now is \$20 per event, not \$10 per day). The club may charge extra for such entries.
- The club must remit the \$20 per person per event fees collected to the EA National office.

Please note that these arrangements are likely to change in November 2009 or later.

For the period of the event the non-member is deemed to be a member of the club during such activities for the purposes of participation only.

Protection is afforded to the participant under the club's public liability policy during such activities where they are liable for bodily injury or property damage to others.

By signing the waiver, the participant is giving up substantial rights to sue the EA-Insured affiliated club and/or EA for injuries sustained themselves.

This Day Membership does not give the participant cover under the EA Personal Accident Insurance scheme, which is part of the EA membership package.

The completed waiver is to be kept by the club and in the event of a claim, provided upon request by the Insurer as proof of attendance.

If these additional people are not recorded as temporary members several things could happen:

- In the event of a claim, the club having no record of that person being present on the day may not be in a position to defend any allegations.
- A claim may be prejudiced should the club be included in legal proceedings.
- Legal action could be instigated against the club and/or committee for failing to ensure all participants held adequate insurance, should an uninsured participant injure a host club member or someone else.

The Remittance Advice for non-member applications must be completed and forwarded to the EA National office with payment upon completion of the event.

Direct EA members DO NOT have to pay day membership at any event conducted by an EA-insured affiliated club. It is up to the club hosting the event and to the participants to ensure that such participants are indeed EA members.

EA-affiliated clubs that are NOT insured under the EA Insurance program cannot use EA Day Membership.

EA Coaches cannot use EA Day Membership.

Horse Sports are a Dangerous Activity

In consideration for being permitted to participate in any way in horse sport activities and in particular this event, I, the undersigned, understand, acknowledge and accept that:

Horse sports are a dangerous recreational activity and horses can act in a sudden and unpredictable (changeable) way, especially if frightened or hurt.

There is a significant risk that serious **INJURY** or **DEATH** may result from horse sport activities and in particular this event. I knowingly and freely assume all such risks, both known and unknown, even if arising from the negligence of Equestrian Australia and/or the event organiser (hereafter referred to as the "Releasees") or others and I voluntarily PARTICIPATE at my OWN RISK and assume sole responsibility for any injury, death or property damage I may suffer that arises from my participation in horse sport activities.

I understand and acknowledge the dangers associated with the consumption of alcohol or any mind altering drugs before and during the activity and I take full responsibility for any injury, loss or damage associated with their consumption. I agree not to drink alcohol or take drugs prohibited by law before or during this event.

I agree to follow the directions of any event organiser or official and that any misconduct or refusal by me to follow any direction of any organiser or official can result in the CANCELLATION of my participation in the event and my immediate removal from my horse NO MATTER where that may occur. I understand that any such non-compliance may result in injury, death and/or permanent disability and I agree to indemnify the Releasees against all claims made by any person as a result of my failure to comply.

I agree to wear a helmet at all times whilst participating in the sport where this is required under the relevant EA and FEI rules and regulations and agree that I am solely responsible for ensuring that whilst participating I wear a suitable helmet at all times where required under the relevant EA and FEI rules and regulations and take sole responsibility for my actions.

I, for myself and on behalf of my heirs, assigns, personal representatives and next of kin, hereby release and hold harmless and agree not to sue The Equestrian Federation of Australia and/or the event organiser, their officers, officials, volunteers, coaches, agents and/or employees, other participants, sponsoring agencies, sponsors, state bodies, affiliated clubs and if applicable, owners and lessors of premises used to conduct the activities (all of whom are referred to as "Releasees") with respect to any and all injury, disability, death, or loss or damage to person or property, whether caused by the negligence of the releasees or otherwise.

Effect of this Document

I have had sufficient opportunity to read this release of liability and assumption of risk agreement, fully understand its terms, understand that I have given up substantial rights by signing it, and sign it freely and voluntarily without inducement of any kind. I understand that my signature to this document constitutes a complete and unconditional release of all liability of the Releasees, to the greatest extent allowed by law in the event of me and/or the children under my care, suffering injury or death.
